**SHRINE CORNER**

As the patio continues on its path to completion, I spent time reviewing the history in regards to Frank Werner and Idaho Quartz at OLWS.

Frank Werner, a member of the original committee, had done some research on Idaho Quartz and found that it was extremely hard and will last a long time while also providing good walking traction.

In addition it will be similar, but not exactly, the same color as the Shrine structure stone. The committee decided to take it to the parishioners to have them be aware of the cost to see if we could move forward.

On November 26, 2018, everybody on the Parish Roster was mailed a letter to answer questions about the cross on the peak and the stone to replace patio limestone. 97% said “yes” to the cross on the peak and 66% wanted Idaho Quartz as the patio replacement stone. The direction to move forward was put in place.

In August of 2024, patio construction was discussed with the structure construction company and Idaho Quartz was revisited. Work on the front, top and back of the structure continued until the structure was completed in late 2024.

Now it was time for the patio and a decision was made to wait a year because the Diocese chose the Shrine as a Jubilee Pilgrimage site for 2025. This patio work was designed to be the last piece of the restoration work.

Meanwhile, a search for contractors was underway and many flatly refused or were too expensive. Working with Idaho Quartz was another issue because of the hardness of the stone. After several companies were researched, two companies came forth willing to do the work. Stone Masters, Inc. from Gaylord was awarded the contract. The cost of the project is \$205,000.00 and is scheduled to be completed by August 1 of this year.

Brian Nelson is the boss and the workers are Adam Maser, Marvin Gregory, Raven Ratchiff, Sean Booth and Dakota Lewis. I mentioned their names because I have been told by several people this is the hardest working crew they have ever seen.
