



Shrine Corner Our Lady of La Salette Devotional in our account

We have \$143,334.83 in our account towards our final goal of \$210,000.00.

Our Lady of La Salette devotional feast day is September 19. She appeared to Melanie Mathieu, age 11, and Maximin Geiraud,

age 15, near the town of La Salette, France in 1846.

Our Lady was saddened by the fact that France was still in turmoil in the aftermath of the French Revolution which ended in 1794. Many people were not respecting the Lord's Day or Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

Our Lady of La Salette foretold tough times ahead in the form of a great famine. Our Lady asked the children if they were praying on a consistent basis. The children responded: *Not Much*. She told them they needed to pray both morning and night. Our Lady of La Salette otherwise known as Our Lady of Sorrows knew there had been an erosion of adherence to the commandments and that only through prayer and penance could one develop a close relationship with God.

Maximum described Our Lady of La Salette as a "The Beautiful Lady" whose children had been beaten and she escaped to the mountain to weep. A spring arose where Our Lady appeared and within one year over 23 miracles were reported. The local bishop approved public devotion and prayers to Our Lady of La Salette in September 1851. To date, neither child has been canonized a saint.

A Devotional Event for Our Lady of La Salette will be celebrated here on Saturday, September 20th. Reconciliation will be at 3:00-3:25 pm, Rosary at 3:25 pm followed by Mass at 4:00 pm. Praying of the Seven Sorrows Rosary and a litany of Our Lady of Seven Sorrows will be at 5:00 pm outside at the Shrine. Potluck dinner will follow in the parish hall—meatballs, ham, and rolls provided—sign-up sheet in the narthex.
