

Shrine Corner

We now have \$10,868.24
in our restoration
account.

The Church has received the final bill for the restoration of the ponds in 2024. Remember, \$87,000 was the goal amount requested to be raised for the year. We have raised that amount. In early September we paid \$80,000.00 to Meridian. While Meridian let the work “cure” before they finished the numerous coatings, we still owed an additional amount. The bill was received this week at \$7,500.00, which brings the total bill for 2024 to \$87,500.00 slightly over the bid of \$87,000.00. Meridian has not arrived to remove the patio stones yet and that should be done in October to determine the cost for 2025. Inspection cost is expected to be up to \$10,000.00. Patiently waiting.

If you look at the outside altar, a tent covering is protecting the altar and ambo from the weather and birds. That is temporary. Father has authorized the expenditure for a water proof canvas to cover the altar and ambo. Contact has been made with a canvas maker and the material has been ordered and expected soon. Once it arrives, the cover will be made to the specs of our measurements and will be completed by the end of October. At first, it was thought that the ambo would not need a cover and could be moved to inside storage, but to be honest, we don't want to remove and return the ambo for every outdoor Mass time, so the ambo cover was included.

The Chaldean bus visits in mid-September were plentiful. This year went extremely well, even though one bus load was unhappy because the Parish Hall was full. Why did this happen? Monte and Maryanne did the best they could to schedule the busses, but we only have so much room. When a bus arrives over 3 hours late from their scheduled time, it causes population overload inside the hall with other busses who were on time. That was the only apparent issue.

I want to say **THANK YOU** to a few people who made the Chaldean week work. Ann Mariani, Carol Dzienis and Cindy VanVleck were there from start to finish all three days. Kelley Hissong, Dawn Downey, and Sandy Slotta worked as needed. Without these people, the Shrine visits do not work.

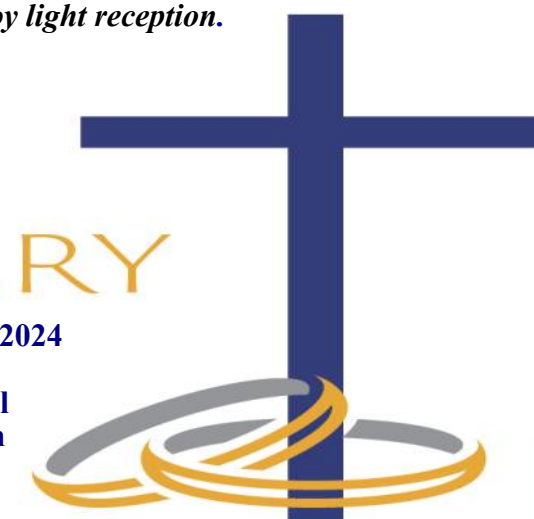
National Shrine application is very close to being completed. Final touches are being done as you read this.
