


REQUIREMENTS TO ATTAIN PLENARY (FULL) INDULGENCE

A plenary indulgence can be gained only once a day and following are the requirements:

- Visit a designated site with the intention of gaining the indulgence. For the entire 2025 Jubilee Year (the last day is 01/06/26), our Shrine is one of them as well as St. Mary Cathedral in Gaylord and Cross in the Woods in Indian River.
- Have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, including venial sin and then confess sins sacramentally.
- Receive the Holy Eucharist.
- Pray for the intentions of the Pope. (This can be an Our Father, your own prayer, or the Jubilee Prayer.)

All of this must be carried out within several days—either before or after—your pilgrimage.
(Several days can be up to 20.)

SHRINE CORNER

We had a lady from the Diocese of Gaylord named Mildred Reid who followed the designated pilgrimage sites of the Diocese of Gaylord for the Jubilee Year of Hope. And she went beyond that.

She first made a pilgrimage to the Cathedral of St. Mary, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, in Gaylord to receive her indulgences and graces.

She then went to the Cross in the Woods Shrine in Indian River. She met a lady that probably worked there and she was surprised that Mildred was making the pilgrimages around the Diocese. She was not seeing people coming to the designated pilgrimage sites for the Jubilee Year of Hope and hated to see people missing out on such a great gift.

Mildred next planned to go to Rome and go through the Holy Door but on that day, there was a gathering of thousands of youth and they closed the Holy Door at 1:00 pm. Somewhat disappointed but making her offering as God's will, she continued on to the Basilica of Montmartre in Paris, France. It was awesome.

Mildred found out about Our Lady of the Woods Shrine when she read an article in the Faith Magazine. On maybe one of the coldest days of the year, she came to visit the Shrine. The K of C men gave her a breakfast-to-go. She went around each apparition, praying as she went around the Shrine. We made sure that she got her token and her booklet stamped. She was able to meet some of our parishioners.

To close the story, our new Missalettes have a picture of the Holy Door in Rome on the front page and an article on the inside cover.

The Holy Doors in Rome are only opened every 25 years. Some of us may not be around for the next time so try to make a pilgrimage before the official closing of the Jubilee Year of Hope on January 6, 2026.

Mildred says her prayer is that it is God's will that her next trip is to see St. Francis's bones.
