



EXTENSION OF CERTAIN PLENARY INDULGENCES FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

In the month of November, the Church has two traditional means of obtaining a plenary indulgence for the souls in Purgatory.

—The first is to visit a cemetery and pray for the dead during the Octave of All Saints' Day (Nov. 1-8). (For 2020, you can do this the entire month of November.)

—The second is connected to the Feast of All Souls' Day (Nov. 2), and can be received by those who piously visit a church or oratory (small chapel) and recite the Our Father and the Creed. (Also, for 2020, you can do this the entire month of November.)

This year, there is a slight change as the Vatican has decreed that these plenary indulgences can be obtained on any day in November. This is due to concerns about avoiding large gatherings of people in church or in cemeteries as well as to include those who are confined to home because of the pandemic The full decree can be found on the Vatican's website.



A lot has happened in this year of 2020! After much deliberation and discussion, this year St. Mary Parish will *not* be participating in the Giving Tree program nor the Cleaning Products Drive.

Many thoughts went into this decision such as:

- Stores and shops will likely be limiting the number of shoppers inside making it more difficult for parishioners to purchase items.
- ◆ Many of our parishioners are elderly and would prefer to stay home, instead of shopping.
- The families who would be receiving the gifts might not want people coming to their house due to the pandemic.
- It could be a financial burden this year due to so much uncertainty.

If you would still like to share with others this year, it is suggested that you instead donate to your favorite charity or other entity. Be creative and we look forward to 2021!
