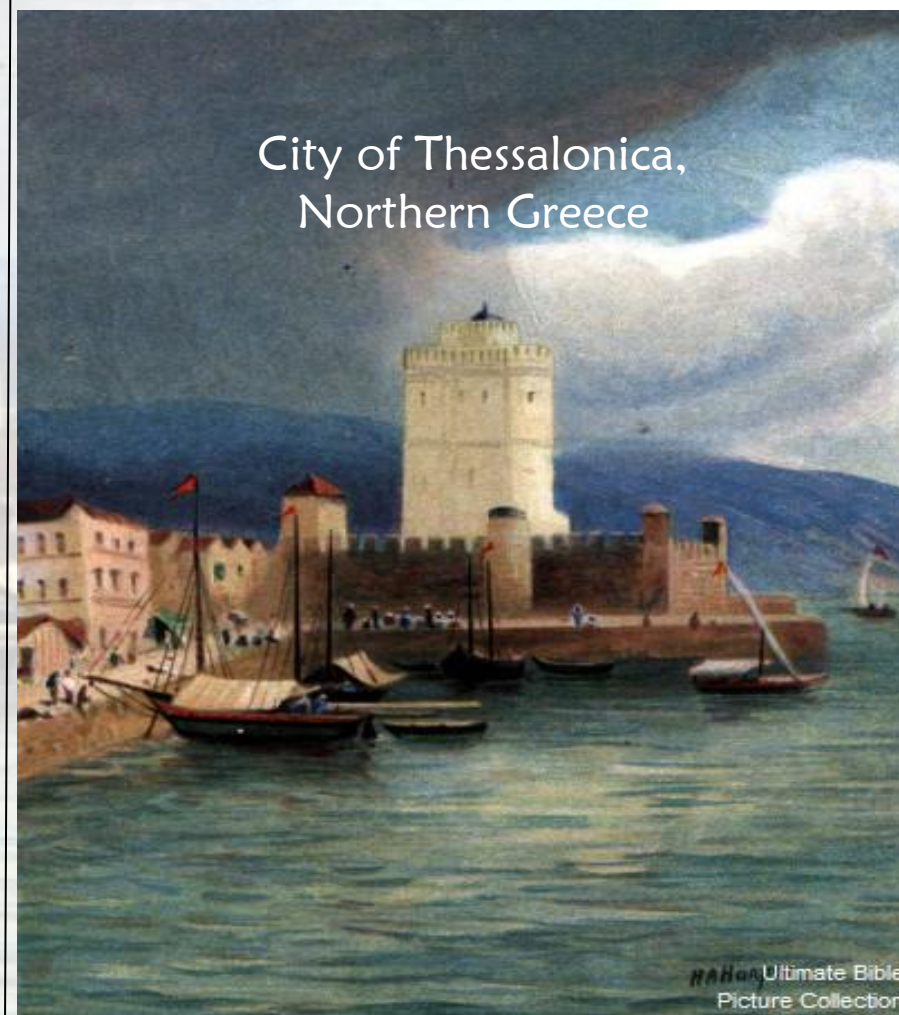

EXTENSION OF CERTAIN PLENARY INDULGENCES FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

In the month of November, the Church has two traditional means of obtaining a plenary indulgence for the souls in Purgatory.

—The first is to visit a cemetery and pray for the dead during the Octave of All Saints' Day (Nov. 1-8). *(For 2020, you can do this the entire month of November.)*

—The second is connected to the Feast of All Souls' Day (Nov. 2), and can be received by those who piously visit a church or oratory (small chapel) and recite the Our Father and the Creed. *(Also, for 2020, you can do this the entire month of November.)*

This year, there is a slight change as the Vatican has decreed that these plenary indulgences can be obtained on any day in November. This is due to concerns about avoiding large gatherings of people in church or in cemeteries as well as to include those who are confined to home because of the pandemic.
