



An elderly man whose health is deteriorating, an unborn baby girl whose diagnosis indicates she may not live long; a little boy with Down syndrome; a mother facing terminal cancer — each may have great difficulties and need our assistance, but each of their lives is worth living.


#### **Giving Online Through the Shrine's Website**
