

May Crowning and Altar Dedication

The next 2 weekends provide us with a couple of events to look forward to—they are as follows:


May 18 – The Crowning of Mary: The Mass will be at 9:00 am with the Crowning of Mary to follow. The Catholic Council of Women (CCW) will provide a breakfast after the crowning of Mary. Joining us will be a tour of CCD students and adults from St. Joseph in West Branch led by Sara Andres, who is the daughter of parishioners Orville and Kim Short.

The crowning of Mary is a tradition whereby an image or statue of Mary is crowned with a wreath of flowers. There is a procession which represents that Mary is both the Queen of heaven and earth and signifies the onset of spring.

May 24 - The dedication of the outdoor altar and beginning of outdoor Mass. Bishop Jeffrey Walsh will be here to dedicate the outdoor altar on May 24th at the 6:00 pm Mass, which is the Saturday of Memorial weekend. This begins our summer of outdoor lawn chair Masses on Saturdays at 6:00 pm, continuing through August 30th, the Saturday of Labor Day weekend.
