

### **SHRINE CORNER**

Deer season is upon us and I thought it would be time to review the Shrine history pertaining to November 15.

We have \$159,182.61 of our final goal of \$210,000.00.

The Shrine was dedicated in September of 1955, but all the work had not been completed. As reported in an earlier article, the altar was not fully constructed and outdoor Masses were not permitted by the Diocese of Saginaw until completed and blessed.

November 15, 1955 cold weather brought all work to a halt that needed mortar. On the outdoor altar, the Benediction Candelabra was bolted into place. The stained glass windows from Germany had arrived and were temporarily placed in the altar wall's place. These windows were donated by Mr. and Mrs. Wilber Horton of Owosso. The Bernadette statue, donated by the Galbraith family, arrived and was placed during a snowfall. No outdoor Mass because the altar was not finished and blessed.

November, 1957, the Family Grotto was being constructed. The walls went up and the roof was completed. Work continued inside the grotto regardless of rain, snow and zero degree temperatures.

In November, 1958, deer season brought many deer hunters and Fr. Hubert Rakowski scheduled an early 5:30 am Mass outdoors. The priest wrote "It looked like a huge red army. The only bad result was a freezing altar boy and a priest who had difficulty distributing Holy Communion because of frozen fingers." (A few years ago the Vision Committee asked Father San to have a 5:30 am opening day Mass, but that did not get approved.)

Opening day in 1960, outdoor Mass was celebrated at 5:30 am with the temperature near zero. This Mass was reportedly attended by over 1,000 hunters.

In early November, 1963, the weather remained mild and people attended Mass outdoors and it was reported as being attended by more than a 1,000 hunters.

Why was Mass outdoors? During this period of time the old Church was a converted one-room school house that only seated 30-50 people and the rest were standing outside. The new Church, which we have today, was not built until the mid-1970s.
