

SHRINE CORNER

In August 1955, the work on Our Lady of the Woods Shrine was completed. Fr. Rakowski approached His Excellency, Stephen S. Woznicki, D.D., on a dedication date and blessing of the Shrine. The Bishop chose Sept.4, 1955 and stated that he would make out the dedication program himself. The invitation read: "St. Mary's Church requests the honour of your presence at the Solemn Dedication Ceremonies of Our Lady of the Woods Shrine, Mio, Michigan on Sunday, the fourth of September, nineteen hundred fifty five at three o'clock in the afternoon. Most Reverend Bishop Stephen S. Woznicki, D.D. officiating. Located one block West of Junction M-33 on M-72."

Sept. 1, 1955, the Oscoda County News had 4 pages of advertising for the Dedication and included the following program:

-2:15p.m. Angeline Gasta Organ Recital

-2:30p.m St. Stanislaus Men's Choir—Marian songfest

-3:00p.m. Procession from Rectory to Grotto Benedictus

Blessing of Shrine Grounds, statues, of all things Asperges Me Choir

Psalm: Miserere—Entire Psalm Choir Repeat Asperges Me Choir

Sermon by Most Reverend Bishop Stephen S. Woznicki D.D. Episcopal Blessing

Prayers read by Very Reverend Theophane Kalinowski Exposition and Benediction

Sept. 4th saw 5,000 people attend the Dedication with an estimate of 20,000 visitors. 30 members of the clergy came. Bishop Woznicki officiated, assisted by Fr. Urban Miller of Munger and Fr. Francis Piaschowski of Saginaw. Rev. Theophane Kalinowski, O.F.M. dedicated the entire State of Michigan to the Mother of God. The Commanding 4th Degree of Bay City Company 414 also were there. The Choppin Choral, an all male group of Bay City, under the direction of Ted Niedzielski, sang. Angeline Gasta of Bay City was the organist. The Oscoda County News on Sept. 8th reported: "Blue skies and beautiful sun, with temperatures in the 70's Sunday gave the Dedication of St. Mary's OUR LADY OF THE WOODS SHRINE GROTTO, a perfect day."

As we celebrate the Shrine's 66th Anniversary, I thought a little history should be revisited. —God Bless, Jim L.
