



The family has requested any memorial donations be sent to Our Lady of the Woods Shrine Restoration Project, St. Jude Children's Hospital, or to plant a tree.



Richard explained that Father San would like to have parts of the Shrine restored/repaired. Richard called a meeting for the Restoration and the rest is history.

Richard truly loved the Church and the Shrine and was actively involved. Often, we would just talk and it almost always centered on the Church.

While we spend our time down here on earth, we should all live life like Richard. He was a good, gentle man who loved and served God and Mary. There is no doubt in my mind that he went upstairs to Heaven, which should be the goal of everybody.
