

Stephen, the father of the boy who was baptized, called it “Monte’s Dream Weekend” on his Facebook page and he was right on. Ann and I were both proud parents and grandparents.

My son Alex is 42 and became engaged to Lauren during last Christmas. After some discussion, I was floored when he called me and said they would like to be married at the Shrine.

So, the process started. Father San began to meet with the couple on several occasions, a formal permission to marry outside was given by Bishop Walsh, Lauren went through the process of being confirmed by Bishop Walsh during Mass the day that the new altar was blessed in May and then on July 17, the couple was married. The weather was really dicey but we made it through and everything turned out beautifully.

If that was not enough, my other son, Stephen, was in town as the Best Man with Jennie and our grandson, Finn, who had not been baptized. This created a perfect opportunity for that to happen. So, the very next day during the Friday morning Mass, Finn was baptized. Alex, the groom from the night before, was the godfather. How sweet is that?

Thanks to all those who worked tirelessly to make these two events happen as they were beautiful but, most importantly, sacramentally holy.
