A week ago Wednesday, our Church hosted a tour group from Gladwin. The ladies enjoyed coffee and cookies with us and a few days later, we hosted the Michigan Charismatic Group which included visitors from various areas in Michigan

Last week, we were able to show God's love to 11 buses of Chaldean Catholics from downstate and Canada. They are not here for our benefit but to show God their devotion to Him. They know that the statues are simple reminders of asking for help with our prayers. Prayers are always directed to God. The Chaldeans are a wonderful reminder of what our Church and Shrine are all about: prayer and thanksgiving to Almighty God!

I am thankful for all the wonderful comments I receive about this column but with winter approaching, I am looking forward to the break.
