



We have \$155,098.27 of our final goal of \$210,000.00.

As we come to the end of another

touring season, it is nice to reflect on all the blessings we have received with all the visitors that came to Our Lady of the Woods Shrine in 2025. The last tour in 2025 was on October 16<sup>th</sup> where around 45 individuals came from the Boyne Valley Catholic Community.

It is been a fantastic year for tours at our Shrine. A total of around 30 tours will have been at Our Lady of the Woods Shrine encompassing over 1,200 individuals. This does not include all those who have toured the Shrine on their own and any other unscheduled visits yet to occur in 2025.
